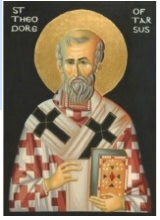

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Sunday Reflection: More Like the Triune God



The Feast of Holy Trinity invites us to appreciate the inner life of God and to copy the self-giving love of the Triune God in our families and communities.

In the Scriptures, we find that God revealed Himself as a "Triune God". God the Father created us. God the Son redeemed us. And God the Holy Spirit sanctifies us. Each of them is fully God and fully distinct as three Persons. Nevertheless, neither the Father nor

the Son nor the Holy Spirit ever exists in separation or acts in isolation from the other Two Persons of the Godhead. The inner life of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit is so loving that they are one.

We are created in God's image and likeness. We are made in love to be a community of loving persons. We need to be in a horizontal relationship with people and in a vertical relationship with God. Therefore, we are called to live a Trinitarian life, like that of God.

Modern society follows the so-called "I-and-I" principle of unbridled individualism. But the doctrine of the Blessed Trinity challenges us to adopt an "I-and-God-and-neighbor" principle: "I am a Christian insofar as I live in a relationship of love with God and other people."

Like God the Father, we are called upon to be productive and creative persons by contributing to the building up of the fabric of life and love in our family, our Church, our community and our nation. Like God the Son, we are called upon to reconcile, to be peacemakers, to put back together that which has been broken, to restore what has been shattered. Like God the Holy Spirit, it is our task to uncover and teach truth and to dispel ignorance. May this Trinitarian spirituality animate our families and communities!

From Faith Formation to Evangelization

As per the direction of the Diocese of Crookston and the encouragement of the members of our Councils, we will soon use an online program called FORMED to help us move from just doing Faith Formation for children to evangelizing the whole community that can be done in our family settings or in small group learning. FORMED.org contains more than 500 Catholic programs, audio books, videos, and books. Ranging from catechetical series like Bishop Barron's Symbolon and select audio from Lighthouse Catholic Media, to Sacramental Formation, Sunday reading reflections, Saint movies for children, and much more are available. Our parish will get an access code to this website that will be distributed to all parishioners. We ask you to consider benefiting from this program, which will be initiated in July 2017.

Kerygma

What is it? Have we forgotten? The *kerygma*, in the words of St. John Paul II is, "the initial ardent proclamation by which a person is one day overwhelmed and brought to the decision to entrust himself to Jesus Christ by faith." The basic elements of the *kerygma* are: Jesus was sent by God, He was crucified, died and was buried, He gloriously rose from the dead, He appeared to the disciples, ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. What's often forgotten is the need for everyone to respond to this message. In order for someone to respond to this message, we must be willing to invite or propose the question about Jesus and His Church to others.
