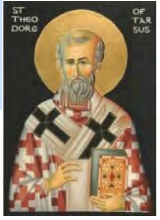

A Fortnight for Freedom (June 21—July 04)



This year, the Bishops of United States, ask us to observe a special "fortnight for freedom," in cooperation with other Christians, Jews, people of other faiths, and indeed, all who wish to defend our most cherished freedom. We suggest that the fourteen days from **June 21** - the vigil of the Feasts of St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More - to **July 4**, Independence Day, be dedicated to this "fortnight for freedom" - a great hymn of prayer for our country.

Our liturgical calendar celebrates a series of great martyrs who remained faithful in the face of persecution by political power - St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More, St. John the Baptist, SS. Peter and Paul, and the First Martyrs of the Church of Rome. Culminating on Independence Day, this special period of prayer, study, catechesis, and public action would emphasize both our Christian and American heritage of liberty.

The Bishops ask all of us to intensify our prayers and fasting for a new birth of freedom in our beloved country. We invite you to join us in an urgent prayer for religious liberty:

Prayer for Religious Liberty

*Almighty God, Father of all nations,
For freedom you have set us free in Christ Jesus.
We praise and bless you for the gift of religious liberty,
the foundation of human rights,
justice, and the common good.*

*Grant to our leaders the wisdom
to protect and promote our liberties;
By your grace may we have the courage
to defend them for ourselves
and for all those who live in this blessed land.*

*We ask this through the intercession of
Mary Immaculate, our patroness,
and in the name of your Son,
our Lord Jesus Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit
with whom you live and reign,
one God, forever and ever. Amen.*

Directed Retreats

Christ the King Retreat House in Buffalo, MN will again offer 3 days and 6 days Directed Retreats. The next directed retreat available is from **June 26 through July 03**.
