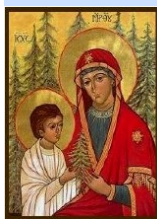

2017 DAA Report

We are happy to announce that both of our Parishes are progressing nicely toward our goals for the Diocesan Annual Appeal 2017. Here are the details:

- **The Diocesan Goal** is \$890,000.00. 4,028 donors have contributed so far \$865,255.72. This represents 24.65% of participation by the Catholics living in the Diocese.
- **St. Theodore's goal** is \$3,632.00 and 17 donors have contributed **\$1,889.00**. This is participation of 23.94% of Laporte parishioners and visitors.
- **Our Lady of the Pines Church goal** is \$14,215.00. So far, 60 donors have contributed **\$8,137.00**. The participation rate is 28.30% for Nevis parishioners and visitors.

We are so grateful to all those who have contributed to our diocesan ministries. We need your help to achieve our goal. We ask every family to consider participating in DAA 2017.

The Diocese of Crookston announced a new Component C training material and test will be available by **July 1, 2017**, on the diocesan website: www.crookston.org. Safe Environment Certification is necessary for every Adult (18 or over), Clergy, Parish staff, Volunteers, Faith Formation Teacher and Substitute who minister to children or vulnerable adults. Certification includes: A criminal background check, training related to recognizing and reporting child abuse and an agreement to abide by the Safe Environment Policy and Code of Conduct of the Diocese of Crookston.
