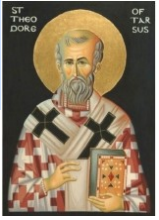

History of the Rosary

The Rosary takes its name from a popular title for Mary: “Mystical Rose.” As a form of private prayer, it originally consisted of 150 Our Fathers prayed daily in substitution for the 150 psalms by those who, unlike the monks, could not read. It was also a common penance given after confession to sinners who had to use beads to count the prayers.

By the 12th century, Hail Mary’s were substituted for the Our Fathers, divided into three groups of 50 (called rosaries), and further divided into groups of ten (called decades). Three sets of themes, or mysteries, concerning Jesus and Mary (Joyful, Sorrowful, and Glorious) established the themes for praying of the rosary. Some of these were borrowed from ancient prayer service associated with the hours of the day.

St. Dominic (d. 1221), a contemporary of St. Francis Assisi, popularized the rosary through his preaching. In the 15th and 16th centuries, there was an extensive promotion of devotion to the rosary. For example, the month of October is dedicated to Mary under the theme of the rosary because of the feast of our Lady of the Rosary is on October 7th, a date established by Pope Pius V in 1571, after a significant naval victory in the Battle for Lepanto Strait near Greece. The victory was credited to the power of the rosary. Pope John Paul II added the Luminous Mysteries during his pontificate.

40 Rosaries for Life Campaign

The Diocesan Office of Marriage, Family & Life coordinated a new diocesan-wide time of prayer to coincide with “40 Days for Life” which goes from September 27th to November 5th. A Rosary will be prayed by a group of parishioners on an assigned day each of the 40 Days for Life. In this way, all from around our Diocese will be united by having a Rosary for Life prayed somewhere in the diocese on each of these 40 Days for Life. The intention of this Rosary is for “respect for life from conception through natural death”.

Our Lady of the Pines Parish and St. Theodore’s Parish have been assigned **Sunday, October 22nd** as our parishes’ day to pray the Rosary for this specific intention. The members of Knights of Columbus will lead the Rosary at St. Theodore’s Church, Laporte, at 8:10; at 10:10 AM at Our Lady of the Pines Church, Nevis. All are invited to gather at this time to pray the Rosary as a community.
