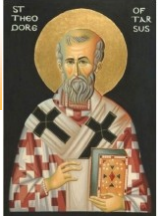

Pope Francis' New Apostolic Exhortation:

Gaudete et Exsultate

REJOICE AND BE GLAD
GAUDETE ET EXSULTATE



Pope Francis has published a new Apostolic Exhortation this month. It is called: *Gaudete et Exsultate* (Rejoice and Be Glad). It is absolutely phenomenall!

“Rejoice and be glad!” is what Jesus said on the Sermon on the Mount. It is also the title of Pope Francis’ new apostolic exhortation on holiness in everyday life. Why should we “rejoice and be glad”? Because God, as Francis reminds us, calls us all to be saints. But how can we respond to that call?

You do not need to be a bishop, a priest or a member of a religious order to be holy. Everyone is called to be a saint, a mother or a father, a student or an attorney, a teacher or a janitor. “Saints next door,” Francis calls them. All we need to do is to “live our lives in love” and “bear witness” to God in all we do.

That also doesn’t have to mean big, dramatic actions. Francis offers examples of everyday sanctity, like a loving parent raising a child, as well as “small gestures” and sacrifices that one can make, like deciding not to pass on gossip. If you can see your own life as a “mission,” then you soon realize that you can simply be loving and kind to move towards holiness.

You also do not have to be “swooning in mystic rapture” to be a saint or walking around with “lowered eyes.” Nor do you have to withdraw from other people. On the other hand, you do not want to be caught up in the “rat race” of rushing from one thing to another. A balance between action and contemplation is essential.

Holiness Online

Stop trolling, resist gossiping and consider putting down your device altogether. That is Pope Francis' advice in his new Apostolic Exhortation "Rejoice and be Glad" for how to be holy online.

The Pope takes on "verbal violence" that is common on "the internet and various forums of digital communication." "Even in Catholic media," he says, "limits can be overstepped, defamation and slander can become commonplace, and all ethical standards and respect for the good name of others can be abandoned."

In North America alone, there are many well-funded Catholic sites and numerous Catholic blogs whose aim is often to slander and malign fellow Catholics who, in the eyes of these writers, believe or live the Catholic faith incorrectly.

"The result is a dangerous dichotomy," Francis writes, "since things can be said there that would be unacceptable in public discourse, and people look to compensate for their own discontent by lashing out at others."

He takes special aim at online behavior that is misleading, either through innuendo or tenuous ties to suspect people or ideologies.

"Here," the pope says, "we see how the unguarded tongue, set on fire by hell, sets all things ablaze."

Guthrie Cemetery Property Reclaimed

On July 27th 1939, Henry Warren deeded two acres to St. Lawrence Catholic Church, Guthrie to be used as Cemetery. Strangely, in 1959 Minnesota took a tax forfeiture action against St. Lawrence Cemetery. In 1972, St. Lawrence Church in Guthrie was closed and the cemetery was still considered to be the property of the state of Minnesota.

In the year 2016, the Cemetery Committee of St. Theodore's Church, Laporte initiated a quiet title action through a lawyer. On March 27, 2017 an application to cancel the forfeiture was made to MN Revenue Department with the recommendation from Hubbard County Board.

We are happy to inform you that the forfeiture of St. Lawrence Catholic Cemetery property is cancelled and we have just received all the documents related to the Cemetery from Hubbard County Auditor. St. Lawrence's Cemetery will be under the care of St. Theodore's Church. We are grateful to the members of STC Cemetery Committee and Colleen Curran for her help in obtaining the cancellation of the forfeiture.

As we rejoice in reclaiming the property, we have a job to do with your help. We discover that the neighbors have encroached the Cemetery property and we are negotiating to get back our land. We need to do a survey and put up a fence to secure this sacred space. The Committee is getting bids and planning a few fundraising events. We would like to complete this project during this summer and we need your help. In the coming days, we will have more information to share with you. For now, let us thank God for answering our prayer.
