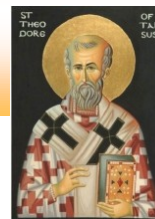

Liturgical Direction from the Diocese

Bishop Michael Hoeppner is asking us to include at least one (1) minute of silence after the Blessed Sacrament is placed into the Tabernacle. This is a time for personal prayer of thanksgiving and reflection upon the gift we have just received. "Sometimes this extended time will not be possible, i.e. if there is a meditation song or something else particular happening after Holy Communion. Nevertheless, I want this silent time to welcome Jesus into our hearts. This will be, I suspect, easier to incorporate into the daily Mass but should be part of the weekend Masses also", says the Bishop.

The Song leaders are reminded to "bring the Assembly in" for all refrains for the Responsorial Psalm and all music which is congregational. Let us continue to "sing the goodness of the Lord".

Sunday Reflection: Channels of God's Love

In the gospel we are reminded of the outgoing nature of God, because of which he continues to love us and share his spirit with all peoples. If we are to be his disciples we too must be people who go out of our way to love others.

We could ask: What does remaining in his love imply? Jesus has a simple response to this query. "If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love..." What Jesus is asking of us is not a slavish obedience to God. God is not interested in keeping us in line. He is not watching to see if we step out of line, he is not a police-man God.

God wants what is the best for us and it is in obeying him that we do what is best for us, and what will bring us peace happiness and love. We sometimes tend to believe that God is out to make life difficult for us, that he keeps testing us and deliberately does not answer our prayer.

To put the record straight he reminds us that He is our friend, and we are not his servants or slaves, but his friends. We have many modern-day heroes, who have followed in His footsteps. Can we make our lives channels of his love?
