Sunday Reflection: The 'Wonder Bread'

Bread. The very word evokes memories of tastes and smells. As child I looked forward to those days when my mother baked bread. She was the only woman in the neighborhood to do so. Other children ate so-called "Wonder Bread". My siblings and I thought it was a wonder you could call it bread!

Grateful as I am to have been born in a culture where bread is a staple, there is even more reason to celebrate this great wonder. Bread is what Jesus identified himself with on the night before he was crucified, when he took bread, said the blessings, broke the bread and gave it to his disciples saying, "This is my body, which is given for you". He became "bread for the world", hope for humanity.

This 'Wonder Bread' is transformative. The 'Living Bread' changes us. We are imperfect beings, we all need to makes changes in our lives in order to become better people, to become better Christians. We all require transformation. The Eucharist is spiritual food, it feeds our souls and through our participation each Sunday we gradually become more like Christ. You may not be very aware of this transformation, but I bet you that the people who live around you are. They realize that coming to mass is good for you, they know that it helps to make you the person you are.

If we come to mass with our hearts closed to God, if we remain locked in to our own preoccupations, we could receive Holy Communion a thousand times and it wouldn't make a bit of difference. It is all a question of attitude. If we come to mass with the right attitude, if we come seeking forgiveness of our sins, if we come with a desire to do better towards our fellow human beings, if we come with the wish to worship God and to pay due reverence to our Savior, then with these attitudes we can rightfully expect a transformation to gradually take place in our lives.

Praising God

A few years ago, I was focused on one negative aspect of my life. My spiritual director said, "I don't think you're being honest with God." I was annoyed. Of course I was being honest! I was telling God all my problems in prayer. "Your life is more than just your problems," my spiritual director said. "you're not sharing with God the whole picture – and that's not being honest."

He was right. Being honest also means celebrating the good things in your life. That means engaging in "praise" – a word not much used in Catholic circles. The lack of focus on praise is especially surprising given its rich history in the Bible. In fact, there is an entire genre of psalms called Psalms of Praise. "Praise the Lord!" begins Psalm 146, "Praise the Lord, O my soul!"

How might you make praise a regular part of your prayer? Perhaps you could praise God for things you take for granted: a job, a roof over your head, family, or friends. Perhaps you could praise the beauty of nature that enchants you, the music that consoles you, the food that delights you. Perhaps you could even write your own Psalm of Praise: O God, I praise you for" How would you complete the psalm?

Besides praising God in prayer, you can do so in deeds. Why not praise God by "paying it forward," by doing an act of kindness for someone who needs it. That might be the best praise of all. And then, in turn, someone else will end up praising God.
